

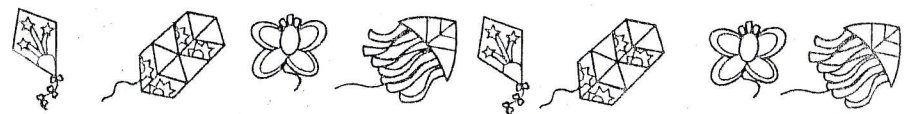
TO PARENTS...

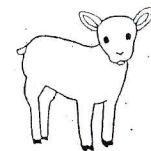
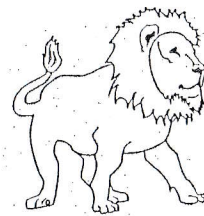

Lions & Lambs
