



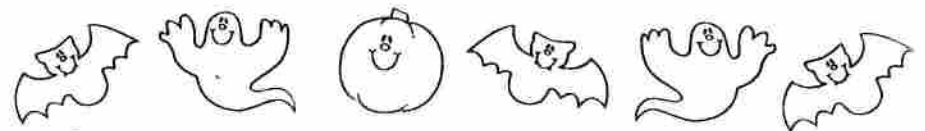
TO PARENTS...

1. Please remember that tuition is due on the first day of the month that your child attends school. Please pay before the 10th of the month. Tuition received after the 10th (unless mailed and post-marked by the 10th) is considered late and must include the late fee. If you have not paid the activity fee that was due Sept. 30th, please do so promptly.
2. In-house registration (current students, past WFS families & church members) will begin January 13, 2025 for the 2025-2026 school year. Open registration will begin on January 27, 2025. More detailed information will come to you in January when we return from Christmas break.
