

## TO PARENTS...

2. WFS will hold a fundraiser with Gertrude Hawk Chocolates on February 18-28. Materials for orders will be sent home prior to Feb. 18<sup>th</sup>.
3. Be sure to listen to your radio or television for delays and cancellations due to the weather. If Frederick County Public Schools are closed, WFS will also be closed. If Frederick County Public Schools are delayed, WFS will open at 10:30 a.m. and all classes will dismiss at 12:30 p.m. You can listen to local radio and television stations for delays and cancellations of FCPS. 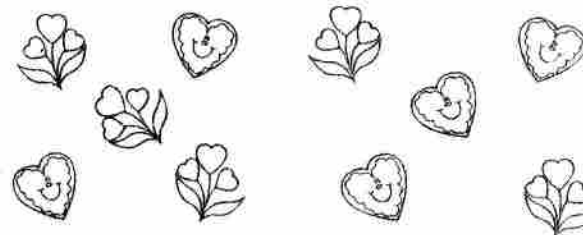
WFS will be closed on Monday, February 17th for Presidents' Day.
