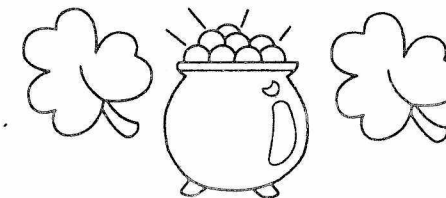

Lions & Lambs



"March comes in like a lion and goes out like a lamb."

This is a saying that describes the unusual weather conditions of March. We begin the month in the winter season and end it in the spring.
