TO PARENTS...

1. Registration for the 2022-2023 school year will begin on January 10, 2022 for current WFS families, past WFS families and ELC church members. Registration forms will be sent home the first week of January. If you would like to register your child, fill out the form and return it to Miss Jo Anne along with the \$110.00 registration fee beginning on Jan. 10th. Classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. Registration opens to the public on January 24, 2022, so register early! Registration is ongoing as long as spaces remain. Please see the attached sheet for class options.

3. WFS will be closed for the Christmas holiday beginning Monday, December 20, 2021 – Friday, December 31, 2021. School will reopen on Monday, January 3, 2022.
4. **Listen to the local radio stations or television channels for delays and cancellations or sign up with the Remind app. You may also call the school at 301-663-5117, ext. 8 after 8 a.m. for updates. Remember – when Frederick County Public Schools are closed due to inclement weather, WFS is also closed. When FCPS are two hours late due to inclement weather, WFS will open at 10:30 a.m. and will dismiss at 12:30 for ALL CLASSES.**
5. Please remember that children should not be at school if they have a fever, vomiting, diarrhea, rash, unclear discharge of the nose, or a contagious illness. Please observe the 24 hr. fever/vomit free policy. If there is any doubt whether you should send your child to school, please keep them home. We love sharing toys at WFS, but not illnesses!
